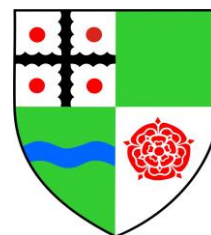

THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 14 CLAYTON LE WOODS, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport has agreed to the above Order, which was due to expire on the 4th July 2018, remaining in force until the **3rd July 2019**, or until the works are completed within this period. The effect of which is to temporarily prohibit any pedestrian from proceeding over that length of Public Footpath No. 14 Clayton le Woods, in the Borough of Chorley, indicated below: -

That part of Public Footpath No. 14 Clayton Le Woods, Chorley Borough, from Point A near to Broom Close (GR 356318 – 423069) in a general westerly direction for a distance of approximately 192 metres to Point B at GR 356124 – 423044.

The temporary closure is necessary whilst works are carried out on or near the footpath.

Access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the footpath, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the footpath, will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the order shall apply to emergency service vehicles or to those undertaking the works.
